Visit of the Olympic Museum

The Olympic Museum first opened to the public on June 23, 1993, attracting almost 200,000 visitors each year until it was closed for refurbishment on January 31, 2012. In total, more than 3.5 million visitors of all ages and all walks of life have come to this museum, set in stunning grounds on the banks of Lake Geneva, to experience the magic of the Olympic Games and the Olympic Movement.

After almost two years of renovation work, The Olympic Museum now has an additional 1,000m² of exhibition space. The restaurant has been moved to the south side of the museum to offer breathtaking views over the lake and the Alps. The permanent exhibitions have been entirely redeveloped for a new and improved visitor experience. They are now covering three floors and are incorporating the museum grounds.
