Lavaux vineyard a UNESCO World Heritage site

The Lavaux Vineyard Terraces, named World Heritage Site by Unesco in 2007, illustrate a thousand years of labour. To make the most of the long hours of sunshine, man reduced the slopes by forming terraces in order to produce a highly appreciated wine: Chasselas. Discovering a wine cellar is the satisfaction of a personalised approach to winegrowing and its culture, including regional culinary specialties and the encounter with a region, which has helped to shape its history.

The excursion includes a visit of the 'La Croix-Duplex' wine cellar in Grandvaux, where you will have the possibility to taste four different wines, as well as experiencing a visit of the cellar. The excursion lasts about 3 hours, www.lavaux.ch
